Trumbauersville Borough's **22nd Annual Community Day** will be held June 4 in the Borough's Veteran's Park, rain, or shine. It has been a long wait, with the COVID-19 pandemic responsible for the cancellation of Community Day in 2020 and 2021, but we are ready to pick up where we left off in 2019! The Schedule of Events for the day is attached. Please note that there is no cooking contest this year.

The ping pong ball drop will kick off the day at 3:00 pm (weather permitting). Prior to the ball drop, at approximately 2:45 PM, the Christ United Church of Christ will ring their church bell to announce the beginning of Community Day.

The Trumbauersville Lions Club will hold their annual Strawberry Festival and pig roast. Christ Evangelical Lutheran Church will provide popcorn, the Schoolhouse Learning Center will be offering snow cones and Christ United Church of Christ will have a table with lemonade.

We have a new clown this year - *Buttons the Clown*, and a new caricaturist – *Donna Needs to Draw*. Face painting by *Fantastic Faces*, our most popular attraction, is back to help make you look your best. Music will be provided by *Sound Sensation DJ Services*, and they will bring their photo booth. Make sure you stop by the booth to capture a free memento of the day.

We will have a petting zoo for the children. Also joining us will be the West Swamp Mennonite Church, Harley's Have Dog Rescue, Last Chance Ranch Animal rescue, Lehigh Valley Martial Arts, and Boy Scout Troop 13. Be sure to stop by to see what they have to offer.

The Cow Flop is Back!

The Trumbauersville Lions Club will again be conducting a "Cow Flop" fundraiser to benefit the Upper Bucks Lions Kidney Foundation. See the attached flyer. Tickets are \$10 each and the winning ticket could win as much as \$1,200, depending upon ticket sales. Ticket sales will end at 5:30, so don't delay. Hot Air Balloon Rides

The tethered hot air balloon rides have been a big hit, so we are offering them again. Because of the expense, there will be a small charge for the rides (\$5 for children up to 12 years, \$10 for 13 years and up). Have your cameras/smart phones with you if you do go up. The aerial view of Trumbauersville is spectacular! The borough is small, so there is a good chance you will see your own house! Wind can play havoc with a hot air balloon, so hopefully it will be a calm day. If not, it will have to be canceled.

Fireworks

Aerial fireworks have become an annual staple of Community Day and the consensus is that they are the best around. 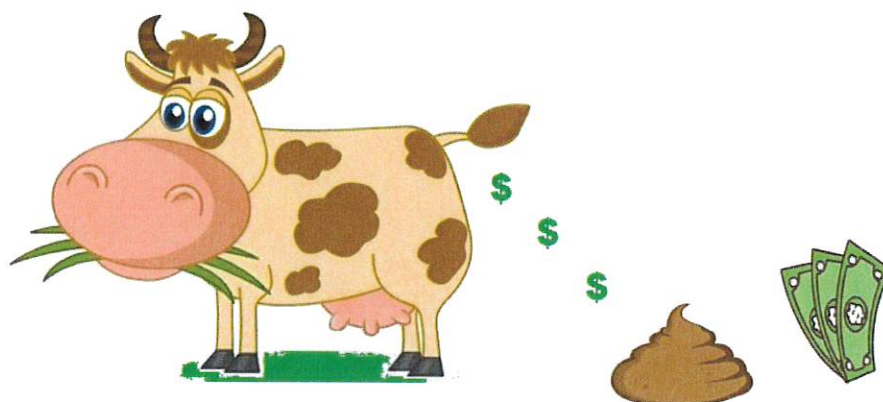

Event Information & Rules

1. The event will take place on Saturday, June 4, 2022 during Trumbauersville Borough's Annual Community Day.
2. A 40' x 60' grid will be laid out with 600 2' x 2' squares randomly numbered (1-600).
3. Each randomly numbered grid will be computer generated and remain anonymous until after ticket sales close.
4. Squares can be purchased for \$10/ticket or \$20/3 tickets and sales will end promptly at 5:00PM on Saturday, June 4, 2022.
5. At approximately 5:00PM on Saturday, June 4, 2022 the cow will be led into the designated grid area by an appropriate handler and allowed roam freely until the first cow-pie or "flop" is placed by the cow within the designated grid area.
6. The ticket-holder of the square in which the flop lands will win 50% of ticket sales sold by 5:00PM on Saturday, June 4, 2022.
7. If the cow flop lands on bordering squares (crossing the lines connecting squares) the square with the largest flop (width and depth) wins.
8. In the event the cow flop lands in an unsold square the winner shall be the square or squares immediately adjacent to and sharing one full side with the unsold square. This could result in more than one winner (up to, but not to exceed 4 winners) who would share the prize money equally.
9. If the cow has not placed a flop within two (2) hours of entering the designated grid area the winner shall be determined by the square in which the cows right front hoof is placed at approximately 7PM on Saturday, June 4, 2022.
10. The field grid and cow will be protected by a barrier or fence. Spectators and ticket-holders must refrain from interfering with the event. Any interference will result in removal from event area and/or non-refundable relinquishment of purchased ticket/tickets at the sole discretion of event staff.
11. Should inclement weather, or other unforeseen circumstances require the cancellation of the event, or prevent the completion of the event as scheduled, a winning square will be randomly generated by computer. If the randomly selected square is unsold an additional randomly generated number(s) will be selected until a sold square is chosen.
