Ends on Sunday, November 6th, giving people an extra hour of sleep.



FIRE PREVENTION WEEK 2022 OCT 9 ~ 15

The National Fire Prevention Association is celebrating the 100th anniversary of Fire Prevention Week™ (FPW). This year's FPW campaign, "Fire won't wait. Plan your escape™", works to educate everyone about simple but important actions they can take to keep themselves and those around them safe from home fires.

Today's homes burn faster than ever. You may have as little as two minutes (or even less time) to safely escape a home fire from the time the smoke alarm sounds. Your ability to get out of a home during a fire depends on early warning from smoke alarms and advance planning.



Make a plan for your family

- Draw a map of your home.
- Show all doors and windows.
- Visit each room. Find two ways out. All windows and doors should open easily. You should be able to use them to get outside.
- Make sure your home has smoke alarms.
 Push the test button to make sure each alarm is working.
- Pick a meeting place outside. It should be in front of your home. Everyone will meet at the meeting place.
- Make sure your house or building number can be seen from the street.
- Talk about your plan with everyone in your home.
- Make sure everyone in your home knows how to dial 911 or your local emergency number.
- Practice your home fire drill!

Notes from the Water Department

Do you know where your main water shut-off valve is in your home? If you had a water emergency and had to quickly shut off your water, could you? This is information to know BEFORE a water emergency.

As a reminder, water/trash bills are mailed out quarterly. You should receive a bill by the middle of January, April, July, and October. The bills are due within 30 days of the bill date. If you do not receive your bill, please contact the office. If you have an address in Trumbauersville with a PO Box, please make sure that the box # appears on the bill. If we do not have your PO Box # on file, please call, or email the borough office.
