Trumbauersville Borough Annual Community Day 25th Anniversary Trumbauersville Veterans Park Saturday, June 7, 2025 3:00 to 7:00 pm

Trumbauersville's **25th Annual Community Day** will be held June 7 in the Borough's Veterans Park, rain or shine. It's hard to imagine that we have been doing this for 25 years. (It would have been 27 years if not for the pandemic.) We are still going strong, and this year we have some special treats in store.

The ping pong ball drop will kick off the day at 3:00 pm (weather permitting). Prior to the ball drop, at approximately 2:45 PM, the Christ United Church of Christ will ring their church bell to announce the beginning of Community Day.

New this year is the Steinmetz Family farm and their goats. Have you heard of goat snuggling? Give it a try. They have been at several Quakertown area events and are very popular.

The Trumbauersville Lions Club will hold its annual Strawberry Festival, along with pulled pork, burgers, and hot dogs. Christ Evangelical Lutheran Church will provide popcorn; the Schoolhouse Learning Center will be offering snow cones, and Christ United Church of Christ will be serving lemonade. Joyful Noise will be selling raffle tickets for a filled basket to be given away on June 14. The raffle is to benefit area food pantries, including the F.E.A.S.T. pantry in Trumbauersville.

The borough will have giveaways along with commemorative items for sale. And there will be glow sticks for the kids.

Donna Needs to Draw will again be doing caricatures. Face painting by *Fantastic Faces*, our most popular attraction, is back, and they are bringing multiple artists to meet the demand. Sound Sensation DJ Services will provide music and a photo booth. Make sure you stop by the photo booth to capture a free memento of the day.

This year, we welcome Hoboken the clown, who you might recognize from Dorney Park. Clowns are always a big hit, and we're sure the kids will keep Hoboken busy crafting balloon sculptures.

Joining us are the American Legion, who will share their vision and collect worn and tattered American flags. They are actively seeking new members, so please drop by and say hello. Additionally, the Bucks County Department of Health will be on hand to offer important information on mosquitoes. Barbara Beck will be there to share information on native plants, and Angelika Fordran from Cowan Associates will present a demonstration on ground pollution. Sugar Shack will again host its bee and honey-making demonstration. Be sure to stop by to see what they have to offer. The West Swamp Mennonite Church, Last Chance Ranch Animal Rescue, and Scout Troop 13 will all be there. Be sure to check out the booths featuring local crafters.

Bracalente Manufacturing will be giving away frisbees and beach balls, along with a raffle for a TV, a gaming station, and a griddle. They will offer free tours of their manufacturing facility

and provide the transportation. House and Land Real Estate will feature a Sensory Play area for children, complete with a variety of games.

It's Cow Flop Raffle Time!

The Trumbauersville Lions Club will be conducting a "Cow Flop Raffle" fundraiser to benefit the Upper Bucks Lions Kidney Foundation. See the attached flyer. Tickets are \$10 each or 3 for \$20. Trumbauersville Volunteer Fire Company

Please stop by to visit our volunteer firefighters in the parking lot. They will be set up to let your children use a fire hose to try to knock tennis balls off traffic cones. But more importantly, check out their equipment and let them know how much you appreciate what they do for our borough. They are well-trained and provide our first line of defense in an emergency. Those volunteers provide a valuable service to our community, and without them, we would be forced to establish a paid fire department.

They will be holding a fundraiser this year - a Duck Race! For a small fee, participants can race rubber ducks down a water-filled track and compete to see whose duck is the fastest and win a prize. It's a fun way to support the fire company and enjoy some friendly competition.

Hot Air Balloon Rides

The tethered hot air balloon rides have been a big hit, so we are offering them again. Because of the expense, there will be a small charge for the rides (\$5 for children up to 12 years, \$10 for 13 years and up). Have your cameras/smart phones with you if you do go up. The aerial view of Trumbauersville is spectacular! The borough is small, so there is a good chance you will see your own house! Even though it's tethered, the wind can play havoc with a hot air balloon, so hope for a calm day so we don't have to cancel.

Fireworks

Aerial fireworks have become an annual staple of Community Day, and the consensus is that they are the best ones around. A special thank-you goes to the local businesses, identified as Gold Star sponsors, who have generously donated to our fireworks display, our most expensive event of the day.

Kids Play Area

Most of our activities are geared towards younger children (such as a bounce house and a clown), so this year we've added a new feature. There will be an interactive play area offering soccer, basketball, and football for older kids to enjoy.

Crafters

We have some tables available for free if you would like to display or sell your crafts, such as wood carvings, baskets, decorative pillows, quilts, jewelry, and beekeeping supplies. We limit this to Trumbauersville residents only, and all items must be handcrafted. (This restriction allows true crafters to show off their handiwork while avoiding the unsightly appearance of a flea market.) The deadline to secure a table is June 4. If you have your own setup, such as a canopy, table, and chairs, please bring them as our available space is limited this year. Call Ed Child, Committee Chair, at 267-733-7541.

Flag Collection

There will be a box at the American Legion booth for the collection of worn-out American flags. The American Legion holds an official retirement ceremony to ensure the flags are disposed of properly and with dignity. Please bring all the American flags you have, even from friends and family.

For Your Safety

We are introducing a new safety measure this year. The fire company's fire police will be regulating vehicular traffic in and out of the park. This is to ensure your safety during the event. Only those with ADA needs and event vendors will be permitted to drive through the park or park in the parking lot. Traffic will be one-way, entering from Woodview Drive and exiting onto North Main Street at the UCC church entrance.

Stay Informed

The borough has developed a Resident Contact List, which will help us keep residents informed about the progress of restoring electricity and other factors affecting them after storms and other emergencies. We will also use this list to keep you informed of non-emergency items in between our quarterly newsletters as appropriate. Please stop by the borough table for more information and to sign up.
