Borough Managers Report:

- Judge of Elections Deb Seifter is requesting access to the borough building the night before election day in order to prepare the space. (Election Day is Tuesday, May 19, 2026.) VP E Child said he would be on hand to open the office.
- **Commercial UCC Inspector:** Motion by VP Child, seconded by Councilwoman Goodin appointing Code Inspection to act as the borough's Commercial UCC inspector at an hourly rate of \$92. Vote: all in favor, motion carried.
- **RVE proposal for work at well #3,** transforming current system to a redundant system as required by PADEP. Motion by Councilman George, seconded by VP Child, authorizing RVE to proceed with the well #3 transformation for the total lump sum fees of \$65,600. (including bid document preparation) Vote: all in favor, motion carries.
- **Water tank inspection:** I have contact information for the engineers of all three carriers with antenna on the water tower. I have contacted Midco Diving and informed them we are ready to schedule with a 7-10 day lead.
- **Follow up Bracalente snow removal complaint:** A resident complaint was received regarding plow operators clearing the parking lots at 20 W Creamery Rd. The plow operators were pushing the snow across Creamery Rd onto private property. I contacted the Bracalente office and asked if they would please address the plow operators' current habit of pushing snow across the street and onto public property. Any snow removal or 'relocation' cannot be pushed onto another property.
