

Trumbauersville Borough Council
July 2, 2026, Council Meeting Minutes
7:00 PM

Council Members Present: Chris Betz, Ed Child, Ally Goodin, Mike George, and Robert Hyde. Dani McClanahan and Solicitor Colby Grim were present. Jim Black, Stephen and Becky Spor were absent.

Public Comment on Agenda Items:

C. Hunsberger remarked on the letter included in the P&R report.

Paul G. and Deacon Kathy from Christ Lutheran Church remarked on their conversation with the Community Relations Committee members addressing concerns over Mayor Black's refusal to provide criminal and child abuse history clearances to the borough. Deacon Kathy said the church has no control over what Mayor Black provides to the borough. The church does not have the same annual requirements as the borough, updated criminal history and child abuse clearances are required every five years. Church representatives informed the committee they have Mayor Black's clearances on file. She provided further clarification that the mayor is not involved with Vacation Bible School in any manner. Councilman Hyde responded that council is trying to get to the root cause of the issue regarding the mayor's refusal to comply with established policy and background clearance checks.
